- D. Dr. Candice Carden reported that in her clinic the number of colics is higher this year. She stated that water intake is extremely important so check your stock tank heaters to make sure they are working properly and encourage your horses to drink in any way possible.
- E. Michelle Sidun reported the Expo meeting was rescheduled for January 31 at 11:30 in Casper at the Fire Rock Restaurant. They are still working on getting clinicians and schedules. The Expo has a facebook page that information is posted on regularly. There was a discussion about how to man the WHC booth and having a raffle of donated items.
- F. Virginia and Michelle will continue to coordinate as new members pay dues and forward their info to Paulette Moss at the Wrangler.
- G. Bill Gentle reported that the American Horse Council's basic foundation is lobbying for the nation in D.C. Bill recommends the WHC support House Joint Resolution #3 (<http://legisweb.state.wy.us/2015/Introduced/HJ0003.pdf>) which supports the BLM's efforts of roundups and sterilization of wild horses.
- Motion to have Bill Gentle continue to monitor anything going forward in legislation that affects horse owners and ag on behalf of the Wyoming Horse Council, Terry Angel seconded. Passed.
