 - Wyoming Horse Racing Report: Frank Lamb: Barn area is nearly full. Their #1 goal is to keep horses and people safe. Last weekend a horse did break it's leg and had to be euthanized. An investigation is ongoing and proper steps were followed.
 - Ag Safety Coalition: Candice Carden: This is to include all ag; wheat farms, dude ranches etc. Trying to get this off the ground before OSHA or another regulatory commission tries to take over. Dr. Carden was contacted to be the representative for the equine industry. It is very unofficial at this point. It is not looking to make rules or regulations but is more educational.
 - Other: Dr. Logan: Vesicular Stomatitis is in 5 states; NM, TX, CO, UT and AZ. If traveling with horses call ahead and find out requirements prior to.
