The meeting was called to order at 1:20 by President Candice Carden.

The agenda for today's meeting was approved. Judy Horton served as secretary and treasure protem. The minutes of the last regular meeting were approved as read.

The treasures report was given. There has been no activity since the last meeting. The Checking account balance is \$870.90 and the Savings account balance is \$1501.63.

The Back Country Horsemen reported that the AHC helped to pass a bill that had addendums attached that would allow federal trails to be preserved and to be used for horse use.

The Wyoming Stock Growers legislative reception will be February 23, 2016 at their office. WHC will co-host the event along with Wyoming Land Trust. Wyoming Downs LLC, Wyoming Horse Racing LLC, Wyoming All Breeds Racing Association, along with Wyoming Horse Council will all share in the cost of the WHC financial share.

A brand inspection issue was discussed and out of that discussion Bill Gentle talked about an equine health passport in Wyoming. President Cardin asked Mr. Gentle to look into the possibility of the WHC supporting this matter and what it would take. He is to report at the February meeting.

President Cardin reported on the progress of the Governors Safety Committee that was started this last summer.

Judy Horton brought up the filing fee for the Non for profit status of WHC. She said she would look into it.
